

## **Procedure for the installation of an EMS Young Academy (EMYA) approved and added to By-laws at Council 2022**

- The mathematical community needs to strengthen the role and perspective of the young generation of mathematicians in Europe. They should be supported in their mathematical development and their career perspectives. But they also should be better integrated in the development of the EMS and its decision processes. Knowing better what the young generation needs and where current developments are leading, they should give new impulses for the development of the EMS.
- Each EMS full and institutional member is invited to nominate two young mathematicians (3<sup>rd</sup> year PhD students up to 5 years after PhD at point of nomination), respecting gender diversity, with a deadline of July 31<sup>st</sup> (with the exception of the first period where the deadline is September 30<sup>th</sup>).
- The EMS EC will form an EMYA Selection Committee of 5 people (respecting diversity including in terms of gender, mathematical field, and regional balance). The EMYA Selection Committee has a mandate for 2–4 years and membership can be renewed once. A staggered composition of the committee should be organized so that always at least 2 members have already acted in the past selection period.
- By September 30<sup>th</sup> the Selection Committee will select 30 young mathematicians from those nominated, to become members of EMYA for 4 years. Appropriate attention should be paid to diversity including by gender, geography, and mathematical field. At full scale, EMYA will have 120 members.
- EMYA organizes itself and suggests developments for the EMS (e.g. research plans, workshops, schools, organizational changes, web presentation, publications, etc.).
- Before each EMS Council meeting, the EMYA will nominate a representative to the EMS EC for 2 years. The representative will stand for election by the Council as Member-at-Large of the EMS EC.
- Activities of the EMS EMYA will be supported with a reasonable budget by the EMS. The EMYA representative to the EC should liaise with the EC on this matter.

### **Setup of the first EMYA Selection Committee 2022**

The EMS EC will form the first EMYA Selection Committee.

### **Setup of the first EMYA**

As above, full and institutional members will nominate two young mathematicians with a deadline of September 30, 2022.

The EMYA Selection Committee will select 30 members from the nominations for the term 2023–2026 in October/November 2022.

The EMYA meets for the first time in late 2022, in advance of the formal commencement of its term, for an initial mathematical and institutional meeting.

The EMYA will decide on its own by-laws and organizational structures.
